Full-Squad Workouts Begin At Camelback Ranch-Glendale

Glendale, Arizona — The Chicago White Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers hold their first full-squad workouts at Camelback Ranch-Glendale (CBR-G) on Friday, February 26. Pitchers and catchers have been in camp since Sunday, February 21.

The Dodgers and/or White Sox play at award-winning CBR-G every day from March 5–31. The two teams face each other in the opener on Friday, March 5.

Workouts — Morning workouts are open to the public. The 141-acre CBR-G campus opens to the public at 9 a.m. The Pavilion in center field is open to fans during workouts for access to concessions, restrooms, Team Shop, lawn, tables, and glimpses into the Cactus League's largest stadium.

What's New At The Ranch? — CBR-G has enhanced the fan experience for 2010 with the following changes and improvements.

- ◆ Free parking to dramatically improve traffic flow.
- ◆ The trademark Dodger Dog — 12-inch hot dog with a drizzle of yellow mustard topped with diced onions — will be available at CBR-G for the first time. The traditional Chicago Dog — poppy seed bun, yellow mustard, neon relish, chopped onions, tomato wedges, Kosher pickle spear, two sport peppers and a dash of celery salt — returns for a second season.
- ◆ The Home Plate Box, the nine-section (11–19), 701-seat area behind home plate, has been expanded by 499 seats and ticket prices have been reduced to \$42. All other ticket-price categories remain unchanged.
- ◆ The renamed 180-person, suite-level Legends Deck on the first-base side and suites wrapping the infield now are available to individuals or groups on a single-game basis.
- ◆ The 50-person Dodger Bullpen in left field has been designated a public area, offering high-top tables and umbrellas for shade to any ticket-holding fan.
- ◆ The 108-person White Sox Bullpen in right field is available to groups.
- ◆ Additional free-standing ticket kiosks featuring ATM-style machines for single-game ticket buyers enable fans to avoid lines at ticket windows.
- ◆ “Will Call” expansion. Ticketmaster Will Call™ is available at any ticket window (home plate or center field). “Will Call” for paper tickets is located behind home plate.
- ◆ On-campus fan transportation (six-person people-mover carts and pedi-cabs).
- ◆ Extended campus access.
- ◆ Fan-friendly improvements to White Sox practice diamonds include lower fences for greater autograph accessibility.
- ◆ Team logo on the White Sox building in right field.
- ◆ Press box seating improvements.

Tickets — Tickets at CBR-G for 2010 are priced between \$10–\$42. Season tickets and seven-, four- and three-game mini-plans are available. The 28-game season plan includes all Dodgers and White Sox games. The team-specific plans feature 16 (White Sox) or 15 (Dodgers) games. Single-game tickets have been on sale since January 9.

Tickets are available at the home plate and center field (beginning February 26) CBR-G ticket-office locations, by phone (800-745-3000), online via www.ticketmaster.com, and at all Ticketmaster locations (Fry's Marketplace, FYE, La Curacao, Macy's and Phoenix Convention Center).

Single-game discounts are available for seniors, active/retired military and students who can purchase half-price tickets in four seat categories — baseline field box, infield box, baseline reserved, and berm seats — for every Tuesday and Wednesday game. All other games are discounted \$2 per ticket for seniors, active/retired military and students. Additionally, every Sunday is Kids' Day at CBR-G when berm tickets are available to youngsters for only \$3 (except Sunday, March 7, premier game, Cubs vs. White Sox).

Also, groups of 15 or more people receive a \$6 discount on infield box and baseline reserved seating for Monday-Thursday games (except Thursday, March 18, premier game, Cubs vs. Dodgers), and \$2 off for Friday-Sunday and premier games.
